### 3- Course General Objectives:

This course aims at introducing the development of criminal thought and its philosophy, defining the criminal law in general and the Syrian penal law in particular, studying the sources of this law and its relationship to other branches of law, penal sciences, ethics and religion, studying the basic principles of criminal law: the principle of legality of

crimes and penalties, the interpretation of the criminal law, the principle of non-retroactivity of the penal law and its exceptions, the principle of the territoriality of the criminal law, its exceptions, cases of extension of penal jurisdiction and extradition.

And we end with studying the general provisions of crime, including the definition of the terminology of crime theory, the classification of crimes with its various criteria, and finally the elements of crime (physical and moral) with all its details and ramifications.

The study of the provisions of crime's theory makes an essential contribution to the legal formation of the student, and prepares him to be an experienced legal man capable of understanding the criminal legislation in theory and applying it in a sound application in harmony with the legislator's goal and objectives.
